The 3M™ Company agreed in 2018 to pay the U.S. Government 59.1 million to settle a lawsuit based on allegations that it and its predecessor, Aearo Technologies, Inc., knowingly sold defective dual-ended Combat Arms Earplugs, Version 2 (CAEv2) to the government without disclosing the defects. In turn, the military branches issued these earplugs to service members from 2003 to 2015. The alleged defects limited the effectiveness of the hearing protection devices causing harm for certain individuals who used the earplugs in combat and training. If you used these earplugs as a contractor, you may also have a claim for financial compensation from the 3M™ Company. This is not a class action lawsuit. It is an individual tort claim for your injury.
